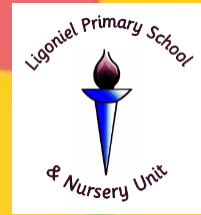


- **Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> November -Y7 SEAG tests- Good luck everyone!**

### December 2023

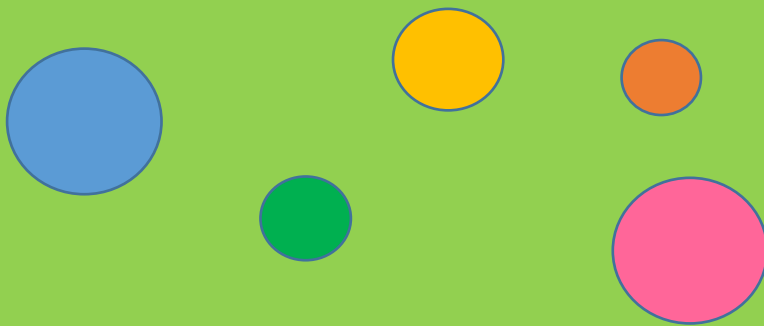
- **Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> December** – Open Night for new Nursery & Year 1 pupils (5.30 -7.00pm)

## FUNDRAISING

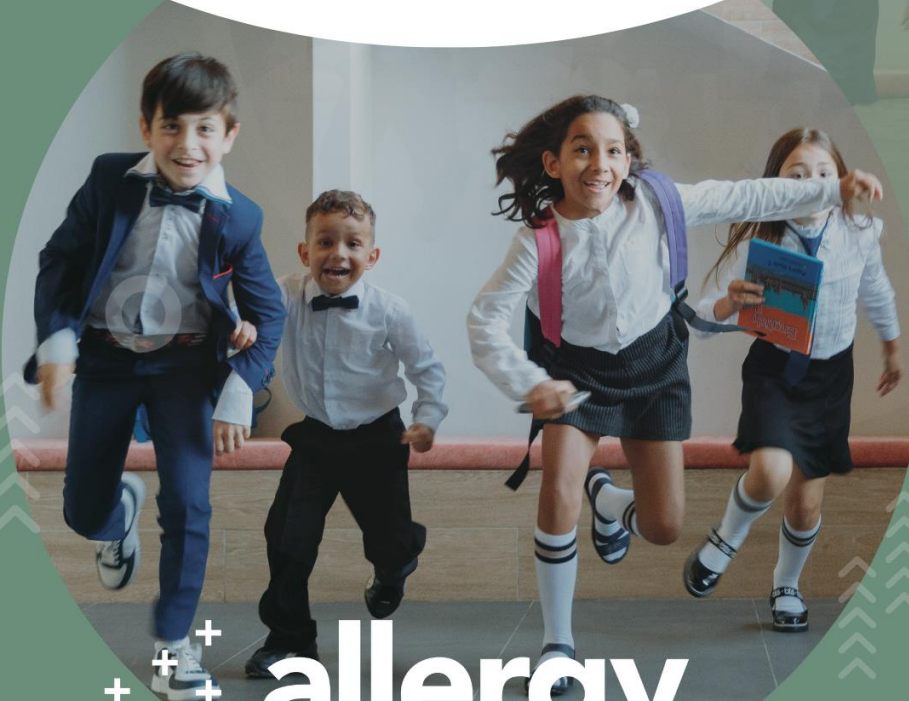
